### **Presentation-Overview of Feasibility Study/Site Acquisition for Elementary School**

A presentation given by Dan Novey, Assistant Superintendent, Dale Reitz, Director of School Services and Gary Bannon, Architect, EI Associates was given to the board with regards to enrollment projections and projected school needs for the future. The board was given a preliminary agreement to approve the acquisition of land needed to build a new elementary school in Upper Macungie Township which was reported to be the immediate need in the District.
