



Dear Parent/Guardian:

You are cordially invited to the Cetronia Elementary School Annual Halloween Parade on Friday, October 28 beginning at 2:15pm. As weather permits, the parade will be held outside of the school. The parade route will begin with students exiting the building through the gym doors, following the sidewalk along the parking lot, proceeding along 37th St. onto the front sidewalks of the school, and re-entering the building through the front doors. Parents may line the grass area in front of the school between the front driveway and the front sidewalks for the best viewing of the parade. In the event of inclement weather, parents are invited to gather in the building hallways to watch our students as they parade around.

Parents of AM kindergarten students are invited to the morning kindergarten parade beginning at 9:30 AM on the same day in the front of the school.

Students should bring their costumes to school in a bag or box marked with their name. Students are not permitted to wear their costumes on the bus to or from school. Classroom helpers have been assigned to each room to assist students as they dress in their costumes. We are recommending costumes that can be worn right over the student's clothing since bathroom space is limited. **I would like to ask for your cooperation to assure that the costumes the children select are appropriate for school.** Creativity and originality in selecting costumes are encouraged and appreciated. However, student costumes should not include weapons (toy guns, toy knives/swords, etc.) and should not promote violence.

The Halloween Socials will begin immediately following the parade. Classroom coordinators will arrange a Halloween treat. **The classroom social is for students, teachers, and designated helpers only.** Designated helpers are to report to the office prior to the parade at 1:45 for proper identification. Thank you for your cooperation in ensuring a smooth and safe Halloween social.
