

# *Summer Algebra I Middle School Camp*

## *For 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Students (Summer 2009)*

Parkland School District will hold an Algebra I camp this summer for students who are entering 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, or 9<sup>th</sup> grade. This camp is targeted for two types of students: those who have taken Algebra I the previous year and want or need a refresher in major concepts within the course, and those who will be taking Algebra I the following year (2009- 2010) and would like a jump-start on major concepts within the course. Students will have the opportunity to review basic concepts in Algebra I without the stress of grading. This is not a replacement for Algebra I, but a review of those concepts that are most necessary for success in Algebra II. Topics will be presented (in review format) one day and practiced the following day. Minimal homework will be given as opportunity for individual practice. Mini-quizzes will be given periodically for parent/student progress information only. As with any course, attendance is important; this course will move at a predetermined rate. **This camp is not for students taking Pre-Algebra in the 2009-2010 school year.**
