Cafeteria	<p>To all students from the cafeteria:</p> <p>Remember to bring your CafTRAC money or checks to the Cafeteria in the morning. Please <u>DO NOT</u> bring your CafTRAC money during lunch.</p>
Shuttle Buses	<p>This announcement is for any student who needs to take the after school shuttle buses:</p> <p>If you are participating in an activity after school that is at Orefield Middle School or Parkland High School, you need to make sure that you get out to the bus in time. Do not run after the buses as they are pulling away!</p> <p>** If you are going to OMS, it is your responsibility to let your teacher know that you need to be dismissed at 2:35 so you can catch the 2:40 shuttle bus to OMS. This is bus #82 and is located at the end slot (#1) in the bus loading area.</p> <p>** If you are going to Parkland High School you do not need to be dismissed early. You will board bus #51 that will also be at the end slot (#1) in the bus area. This bus leaves at 2:45 after the regular buses.</p>
Bus Passes	<p>This is a very important announcement concerning the issuing of bus passes!</p> <p>If you should need to ride home with a student on another bus, we <u>need</u> parent notes from <u>both</u> students.</p> <p>Please do not even come to the office for a bus pass if one of you is missing a note.</p> <p>Also, the parent notes need to be handed in to the front office in the morning & you will pick up your bus pass at lunchtime. Students should not have to leave class to obtain a bus pass.</p>
