WHAT IS ASAP?

In an effort to provide additional assistance to students who need and desire academic support, Springhouse Middle School has established A.S.A.P. It is an after school assistance program.

A.S.A.P. meets twice a week on Mondays and Thursdays. It starts at 2:45 PM and runs until 4:10 PM.

Students will be working with members of the Parkland High School's National Honor Society. In addition, certified staff members will be present to make sure the program runs smoothly and to help with any other areas of concern.

HOW DOES A STUDENT GET TO PARTICIPATE?

Students are recommended by a teacher for admittance into A.S.A.P or by parental request for participation in the program.
