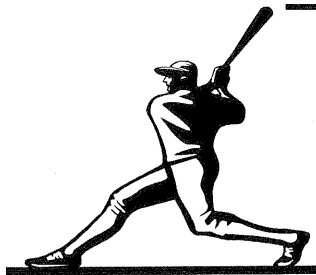

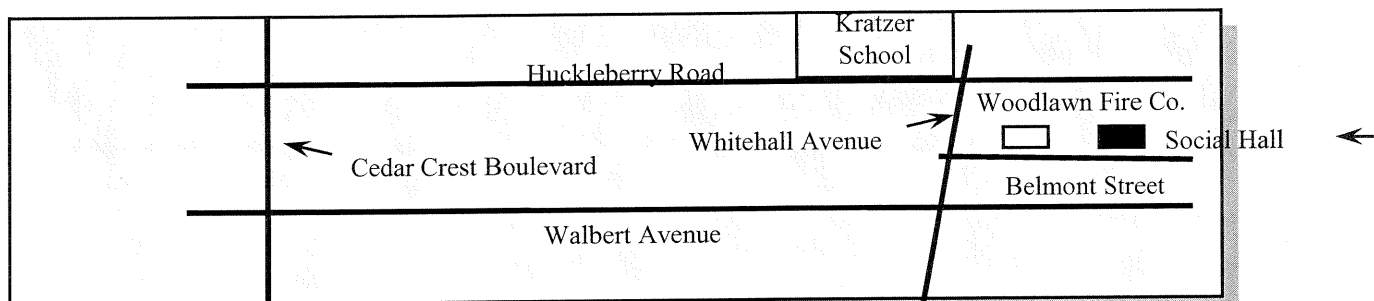

**For All levels this year's our fees will be:**

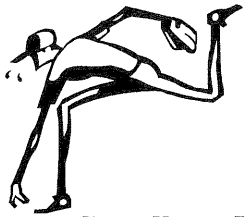
\$50.00 registration fee + \$20.00 fundraiser + \$10.00 uniform shirt

Grandlawn Baseball Association has a long tradition of more than **fifty years** of excellent youth baseball instruction and development..

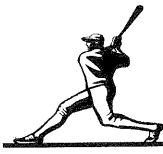

2012 RULE OF CONDUCT POLICY

The Parkland Baseball League Constitution and By-Laws include a Rule of Conduct Policy that has ZERO tolerance for inappropriate and unacceptable conduct, including the use of foul language, threatening verbal or physical behavior or other unsportsmanlike conduct that results in actions which are detrimental to individual and public welfare and which are not consistent with the purpose of the league.

This Parkland Baseball League Rule of Conduct applies to players and all other adults associated with the player. **This includes managers, coaches, assistant coaches, parents/guardians, and any other family or friends** who attend Parkland Baseball sponsored events.

Failure to comply with the Parkland Baseball Rule of Conduct will result in penalties, including **ejection** from the game and/or **suspension** from attending future games.
