

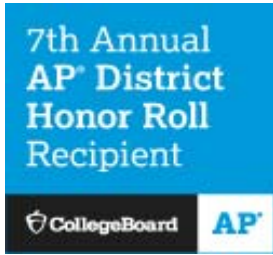

The Parkland School District is located in the semi-metropolitan region known as the Lehigh Valley. The Lehigh Valley region of eastern Pennsylvania is made up of Lehigh and Northampton counties and is home to the three cities of Allentown, Bethlehem and Easton, as well as numerous townships and boroughs. With more than 500,000 residents, it is the third largest metropolitan region in the state. The Lehigh Valley maintains a strong commitment to educational excellence with six major institutions of higher learning—Cedar Crest College, DeSales University, Lafayette College, Lehigh University, Moravian College, and Muhlenberg College.

The 72 square miles of the Parkland School District encompass three townships with a total population of approximately 50,000. The district's wide socio-economic range results from it bordering the city of Allentown on the southeast and extending to farmland at the western and northern extremities.

## ADVANCED PLACEMENT

Parkland offers 28 Advanced Placement (AP) courses as part of the high school curriculum. In 2017, 86% of the 751 AP tests taken achieved a score of a three or higher and 27% scored a five. These scores allow students to be eligible to receive college credit for the equivalent course at one of more than 2900 colleges nationwide. For the last four consecutive years, Parkland School District made the College Board's Annual AP District Honor Roll — a list of 425 districts across the U.S. and Canada who are honored for increasing access to AP course work while simultaneously maintaining or increasing the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher on AP Exams.
