Cetronia's Teen Associate Program (TAP), allows youth ages 14-18 who complete the Emergency Medical Responder program to serve as a third person on Cetronia's basic and advanced life support

ambulances. Teen associates are given first hand experience in assisting a crew to administer pre-hospital emergency medical care. Following the OAAS Curriculum, upon successful completion of this course you will have the knowledge and skill needed to assist in treating a patient in an emergency setting at the Emergency Responder level. A certificate of completion is awarded at the end of the program. **Due to state minimum age requirements this is not a state approved certification class.** However, at age 16 you may challenge the State Certification Test.
