Drive through clinic, partner with CVS/Target. 480 Parkland staff and family members were vaccinated.

Food Services and meals during COVID

March – September: buildings closed; our needy families were offered services through our REACH (Resources Enhancing All Children's Health) team and our in-house food pantries; REACH coordinates our in house food pantries and snack pack programs; coordinated distributions between REACH and Parkland Cares; averaged 80 food boxes per week;

First 2 weeks of school, food services operated under regular school programs for breakfast and lunch;

Beginning September 14, 2020, food services began operating Summer Seamless Option (SSO); this program offers all students free breakfast and lunch:

Meals to go program was also launched with parents picking up 5 free breakfast and 5 lunch every Wednesday for every child residing in the District from age 2 to 18; currently distributing over 8,000 meals every Wednesday;

REACH raised money to supply needy families with Thanksgiving meal boxes; raised over \$6,000; 87 turkeys donated from Pastor Jarrod; 93 families signed up to receive holiday meal boxes on Monday, 11/23/2020; leftover money will be used for Winter Break boxes;
