## SCHOOL BOARD UPDATE: Submitted by Linda Perlman-McKenna

On April 17, 2019 a Workshop Meeting was held first followed by the Regular Business Meeting.

At the Workshop Meeting, the Project Manager of the Veterans Memorial Elementary School construction project spoke and was pleased to report, despite all the weather issues, the project is on schedule and on budget. Also at the Workshop Meeting, Brenda DeRenzo and Kelly Rosario spoke about Social Emotional Learning Programs and the MindUp Curriculum.

At the Regular Business Meeting, the Cyber Charter School Funding Reform Resolution was approved. This resolution supports Statewide Cyber Charter School Funding Reform, urging its local officials to correct the way tuition payments for cyber charter schools are calculated so that it reflects the actual costs of educating students and relieves the unfair burden currently placed on taxpayers. Also, at the Regular Business Meeting, the Board approved an update to the district's current school calendar. The last day of school for students and teachers will be June 14<sup>th</sup> instead of Monday June 17<sup>th</sup>. Bob Bold was appointed as the new School Board representative to serve on the Parkland Community Library Board. The Parkland Education Foundation's Gala will take place on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Next Board Meeting is May 21<sup>st</sup>.
