1. Who must take the test?

*Current PHS students who did not receive a score of Proficient or Advanced in last year's Biology Keystone Exam

or

*Transfer students who have not previously take the test

2. When will the test be given?

*December 9th and 10th of 2013

3. What can I do to prepare for the Biology Keystone Test? *You can utilize the following online resources to prepare for the test:

<u>a.</u> <u>Study Island-</u> provides lessons, labs, and practice questions that align directly with the Biology Keystone Exam. Read the lessons and go "Practice Mode" to answer questions.

Students will be given a list, from their current science teacher, of suggested Study Island Lessons to use for review, based on past Biology Keystone test results. This list reflects test anchors where students scored Basic or Below Basic.(Directions: Login to Study Island and choose the following- PA Programs/Keystone Biology/Biology)

<u>b.</u> <u>Pennsylvania Department of Education's PDE SAS</u> website- provides sample test questions of all types.

(Directions: Log into <u>http://www.pdesas.org/</u> and then select Assessment/ Assessment Creator/Select a Course/Biology from the drop down/All question type / Search)
